British Columbia's central coast is still virtually undiscovered, a misty land where wild nature, ancient cultures and everyday adventures co-exist. BC Ferries presents a remarkable summer route between Port Hardy and Bella Coola. It follows a coastline so remote, they call it *The Discovery Coast Passage*. Discover British Columbia's true nature this summer.

The starting point of this adventure begins at Port Hardy, an outdoor adventure paradise, the journey continues all the way to Bella Coola.

The Bella Coola Valley is home to giant cedars, mountains and glacial waterfalls that grace the landscape. Next, we venture eastward to the Chilcotin Plateau passing through Riske Creek and Alexis Creek to your overnight stop in Williams Lake. Williams Lake is the largest centre in the Cariboo-Chilcotin area. It has superb scenery and features including sandstone hoodoos, a meandering river that shows signs of new salmon spawning and even cactus.

On your final night have some fun at the Village Green Hotel & Casino in Vernon. Onward we go through the canyon following the mighty Fraser River back home.
