

## Discover Utah's Canyonlands

Where radiant cliffs tower to kiss the azure sky and pristine canyons are carved deep into the desert sandstone. Where ribbons of banded rock break to reveal the blue waters of a vast lake and verdant forests, dotted with lakes and streams, provide refuge for wildlife. The Scenic Byway 12 connects these treasures, uniting scenery, history and culture along the way. Canyonlands, one of our spring tours is a must for all to see and enjoy.

Moab, Utah is considered the gateway to both Arches and Canyonlands National Parks. Moab will surround you with the warmth and hospitality of a small resort town at the center of one of the most stunning red rock landscapes on Earth. Come discover the canyons and deserts of Utah.

The scenic backcountry of Capitol Reef National Park is a stark desert featuring sandstone monoliths that resemble cathedral spires. Arches National Park is a red rock wonderland containing some of the most scenic and inspiring landscapes and the world's largest concentration of natural sandstone arches.

Canyonlands National Park preserves a colourful landscape eroded into countless canyons, mesas, and buttes by the Colorado River. From the scenic

overlooks at the Island in the Sky, to the remote canyons of the Maze, to the thunderous rapids of Cataract Canyon, a lifetime of exploration awaits.

Dead Horse Point State Park is one of Utah's most spectacular state parks. Towering 2,000 feet above the Colorado River the park provides a breathtaking panorama of Canyonlands' sculpted pinnacles and buttes.

Bryce Canyon is known for its spectacular hoodoos, fiery colours and endless vistas, but when the sun sets upon the canyon another impressive scene takes the stage. Bryce Canyon has some of the darkest, starriest night skies in the country. Boasting clear mountain air and a location far from the city lights, the night sky is certain to enchant. See the sky that our ancestors once knew and share one of the rarest views – the unspoiled view of the cosmos.

We invite you to join us as we venture back in time through the discovery of artifacts and remnants of the past, journey along meandering trails and waterways and marvel at geologic wonders carved and sculpted through time.

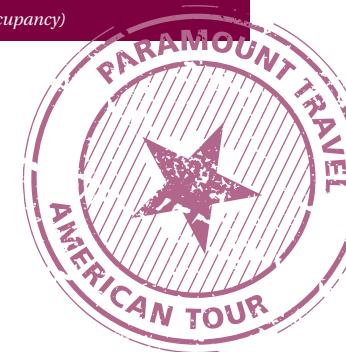
